## **SOUL'S TRANSMIGRATION OR WALK-IN**

The soul's transmigration's experience, also known as walk-in consists in a soul transfer from a body to another body, generally resulting from a preliminary understanding between the two souls. The soul which is in the body decides for a reason or another to give its place, or to combine itself to the other soul's part.

A soul transmigration can be done from individual to individual. This is not then the process of incarnation such as it occurs at the birth of baby.

A "walk-in" is a soul that enters an individual's body and goes on living the person's life. It has access to the memory and story of the body.

The people who spend time with such a transmigrated soul, even if the spirit has changed identity, will not see any difference.

If during a soul's transmigration, the walk-in borrows a new vehicle, he generally forgets his true identity. He will have to continue his "learning" in order to continue his mission. The soul-spirit transfer from a body to another is usually done during a trauma or an experience of imminent death.

The understanding between the two souls therefore happens at the etheric level. It can also be that it has happened before the birth and the reason for which a soul's transmigration can be, is simply for not to have to go through the birth and learning stages. When the soul enters an adult body, the experiences and knowledge are already learnt.

The walk-in therefore goes through all of these stages, to accomplish its "soul's mission" in better conditions.

Jenaël talks about an experience of this type, in his story, lived after his swinging accident.

"According to René Guénon, the traditional doctrines do not confuse transmigration, metempsychosis and reincarnation. Here is his definition of transmigration: Passage of the being to other existence states, that are defined by conditions entirely different from the ones to which is subdued human individuality. Who says transmigration essentially says change of state of being. This is what teach all of the Orient's traditional doctrines, and we have many reasons to think that this teaching was also the one of Antiquity's "mysteries". Even in heterodox's doctrines such as Buddhism, it is not at all question of something else, despite of the reincarnationist interpretation which has taken place amongst the europeans. It is precisely the true transmigration's doctrine, understood in the meaning given by pure

metaphysics, that makes it possible to refute, in an absolute and definitive way, the idea of reincarnation. And there is even only in this field that such a refutation is possible."
